TREASURER'S REPORT – 1st JULY, 2024 TO 30th JUNE, 2025

INCOME AND EXPENDITURE

At June 30 the Central Coast Leagues Club Bridge Club had a Loss of \$725.21 during the financial year 2024/25. The factors attributing to this are as follows.

- 1) Our players each month have increased again over this year for 23/24 the average number of players per month was 563.2 and for the year 24/25 the average number of players per month was 673.8.
- 2) I would like to thank the CCLC for their continued support of \$370 per month in 2024 it has now increased to \$2333 each quarter in 2025 to help pay for club expenses such as paper, ink, cards, etc.
- 3) We have had an increase in membership with great thanks to Eunice for her wonderful work in running the lesson for new players and improver lessons from Wendy.
- 4) We have again had very successful charity events this year with raffles and sales. We paid \$5000 on June 3rd for the Women's Community Shelter was part of this years expenses. We are still in credit of \$400 from the charity money and raffles to put to next years donation. A big

- 5) The Real Bridge has discontinued as the numbers were too low to continue. We thank Ronnie, Alan and Julie for directing and keeping everything flowing as long as it did.

- 7) Other large expenses for this year are \$4870 dealing machine, \$602 Mic and speaker, \$506 pens for congress, \$486.05 new cards and \$336 trophies for presentation day.
- 7) The Congress in 2024 was a great success and thanks to Louis and Margaret for their work encouraging all the players to participate and the setting up of the event.
