### DIRECTORS CORNER.

I have often been asked how the movement is selected for our Thursday sessions. Three factors guide my selection:

#### Number of sections.

With fourteen or more tables, two sections with both sections playing the same number of boards per round and thus changing and finishing at the same time. Some special events, such as the Matchpoint Medal, require one section.

With a half table, N/S to sit out if there is an odd number of full tables plus a half; E/W to sit out if there is an even number of full tables plus a half. Number of Boards.

We like to finish by 4 pm. Thus with thirteen and a half tables or less we play one section with two boards per round; fourteen to sixteen tables two sections with four boards per round; more than sixteen tables one section with two boards per session with a curtailed movement.
