# ..... from Page 1 LOG IN TO MYABF

There are benefits for all

- A huge drop in workload for the Treasurer and Membership Secretary who will not have to laboriously track individual payments into the Club bank account
- No need for you to bring cash and for it to be collected a fall in workload for the Standby and Director and far fewer trips to the Bank by the Treasurer.

What should an unregistered member do?

- If you are <u>not intending to renew your membership</u> with our club for 2025, then you can <u>do nothing</u> (except advise Wendy)
- If you are intending to renew with us, then we ask you to follow the simple process to register.

Here are two of the easy pathways to register:

1. From our club Home Page, choose *Links* and then **Your MyABF Dashboard**. Accept the invitation to sign up and follow the steps . .

2. From our club Home Page, choose *Links* and then *Australian Bridge Federation*. At the far top right click on MyABF and follow the steps.

For membership fees and for session table monies, you will need to establish a minimum \$50 credit in your MYABF account. You should also set 'automatic top-up'. Then sit back and do nothing!

If you need assistance in registering, please ask anyone who has done so.

#### CCLCBC TRIALS OF MYABF


- 1. Tuesday's RealBridge sessions are now operating successfully using this platform. Hours of time have already been saved in sending invoices, payments and checking of same!
